Finansinspektionen's regulations regarding the terms under which an actuary may serve at an insurance undertaking;

decided on 17 March 2011.

Finansinspektionen prescribes the following pursuant to Chapter 7, section 2 of the Insurance Business Ordinance (2011:257).

Section 1 A person who shall serve as an actuary at an insurance undertaking in accordance with Chapter 5, section 14 of the Insurance Business Act (2010:2043) shall fulfil the requirements on education, language and experience set out in sections 2–4.

Educational requirements

Section 2 An actuary shall

- 1. fulfil the education requirements the Swedish Society of Actuaries places on its full members or
- 2. fulfil the educational requirement the International Association of Actuaries places on its member associations with regard to if the person would be a full association member or the equivalent.

Language skills

Section 3 An actuary shall have sufficient skills in Swedish to understand the insurance regulations.

Experience

Section 4 An actuary shall have at least three years of experience in the tasks that the position will carry out. It shall be possible to demonstrate this experience.

Exceptions

Section 5 Finansinspektionen decides on exceptions to these regulations where special grounds exist.

^{1.} These regulations shall enter into force on 1 May 2011, whereupon Finansinspektionen's regulations (FFFS 2007:21) regarding terms under which an actuary may serve at an insurance company shall be repealed.

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2. An actuary registered with the Swedish Companies Registration Office at the time these regulations enter into force does not need to submit a new application for registration.

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
